

Proposal to establish a facility for young people in Farnsfield

As a village, Farnsfield is lucky to have some good sports facilities, some of which are available for young people. Additionally, the village has scouts and guides for those wishing to participate. The village has several opportunities for older people to socialise. However, there is nowhere for people of school age to meet communally in a social setting, particularly in the autumn/winter months.

Recently NSDC arranged for Extreme Wheels to provide skateboarding activities for a period of 6 weeks. Despite the unfavourable weather on several occasions, the sessions proved to be popular with younger skateboarders and scooter riders. During the winter months Extreme Wheels run indoor activities for young people, including table tennis, snooker, darts etc. The equipment is provided by themselves. On one evening, one of the Extreme Wheels crew chatted to a group of young people in the village and the response to providing this kind of facility was very positive. The Youth Council have also been investigating what kind of provision could be made for youngsters, including a request for volunteers to help run it – the response was very poor. Additionally somewhere to host this kind of facility has proved to be difficult as both the village centre and the methodist church are booked most evenings.

Following on from this, the cricket club has been approached and the feedback is as follows:-
“I’m pleased to confirm that the cricket club would be delighted to support this potential council initiative. As a gesture of goodwill, we would be happy to offer the first four sessions free of charge while the programme becomes established, allowing time to attract attendees and assess its longer-term viability. After the initial four sessions, we would propose a charge of **£60 per session**. This simply covers our operating costs, including utilities and cleaning, and is not intended to generate any profit. We would be happy to invoice these costs on a monthly basis.
Should you wish to proceed, we would just ask for copies of the relevant insurance documentation for our records. We would also ask that the premises are left as found after each session, with any furniture returned to its original position, and that any damage incurred is made good.

I hope this provides the information you need for now and helps move this fantastic initiative forward. Please let me know if you need anything further, and we look forward to working with you.”

The cost of using Extreme Wheels to run the sessions is as follows...

As an initial outline, costings for 19 sessions, each running two hours, starting from the first week of November and continuing through to March, with a well-deserved pause over the Christmas period. The total cost for this program will be £6,654, which covers both our staff and all necessary equipment. More details are provided below.

A group such as Extreme Wheels have credibility with young people and are ideally placed to make these sessions a success. Additionally, It should be emphasised that no Parish Council has not directly spent money on this type of activity for the 11-18 age group for many years. This would seem like an excellent opportunity to rectify the situation and provide something positive for the young people of Farnsfield.

Extreme Wheels Roadshows can offer the following programmes and services:

1. **Urban, Extreme and Action sports** activities – we offer over 10 different activities based around young people's lifestyles and culture. 3. **Outreach youth engagement** – During the pandemic the team Introduced 'Extreme Outreach' which provide youth engagement on where the young people are at. This is non activity based and focus is on outreach to 'locate and chat' and be eyes and ears, travelling between locations in targeting open spaces, communal, village and town areas, where young people 'hang out'. The team provide informal face to face social interaction offering young people advice, guidance and to give them an opportunity to discuss matters in their community.
4. **Music Events** – Often today music is a massive part of young people's lifestyle and culture. Well with 'Extreme Bass' sessions, we can provide mini music events within your own community, in which we can ether provide some local top DJ's or alternatively let your people DJ themselves from our Roadshow truck!
5. **Permanent Skatepark Sessions** – If you have a skatepark we can deliver sessions and work with young people on these facilities.
6. **Galas and Shows** – if the Council or local committees organise events the team can offer Extreme and Action sports activities right through to pro demo shows to the event goers as part of the show offer. Also help you in organising your event.
7. **Working evenings** – We recognise many of the young people hang out in the evenings especially Friday evenings and therefore we work these times (if available) to engage this section of the community

8. **Official openings** – If you are planning a new open space or skatepark official opening, Extreme Wheels can provide one off activities through to staging a grand event by offering multiple activities, shows and pa systems.
9. **Knowing the young people** – with the pedigree of years of working with this age range, we have an excellent understanding on what makes them 'tick'.
10. **Extreme Wheels Brand** – many young people associate and identify us with our 'Brand' and not a singular activity provider. They know that when we appear in their communities that Extreme Wheels is different, exciting, cutting edge, and extreme, with a modern variety of Extreme / Urban activities that they will get a chance to participate in!



11. **Strong Social Media following** – In the last few years, we have developed both Facebook and Instagram pages with over a 1000 followers checking out what we are doing on a weekly basis and therefore having direct contact with young people who have previously engaged with us. So getting to the right young people isn't an issue for the Extreme Wheels Team.
12. **Alternative physical activity** – often young people who engage in the activities which we offer don't see them as 'sport' they see it as laser tag, climbing wall, KMX carting etc., and therefore many of the non-sporty types including females often participate and therefore its 'physical activity through Stealth'
13. **New Skate park builds & Consultation** – Sometimes organisations find it hard to consult with young people especially those who hang around on the street or on open spaces. Over the years we have developed a number of options in order to engage these young people along with some innovative consultation methods to find out what they want or feel in their community.
14. **Indoor Sessions** – The team have delivered numerous indoor sessions during the autumn and winter months to give young people somewhere warm and welcoming for them to hang out based around their lifestyle. The aim is to provide an environment that interest them in a non-structured way along with providing a vast array of indoor activities by bringing an 'Extreme' experience inside to engage and entertain today's young people.
15. **Motivational and Inspirational talks** – The Extreme Wheels team along with its Action sports Pro demo riders offer talks around a wide variety of areas based on the client's outcomes, along with a jaw dropping show to add to the audience experience. Many of the team and Pro demo riders come from a variety of backgrounds and these often link into today's young people's lifestyle and outlook on life. However, the Extreme Wheels Pro Riders are current and in today's mind set of young people via social media and TV, unlike many other ex-professional sports stars from years gone by.

16. **Targeted youth intervention** – Whether 1 to 1 or in small groups, Extreme Wheels can offer targeted intervention sessions designed at engaging young people based around their lifestyle. Often the team sees that some young people who participate in the activities are non-academics and are not interested in structured lessons/sports or outcomes. Therefore, by the very nature of Lifestyle/Action/Extreme Sports, this is an excellent way to engage them in a semi-structured way so they don't feel disenfranchised from society or education.
17. **The Crew** – many of the team often participate in these type of extreme/urban activities in their own personal time and therefore they bring the added passion, enthusiasm and motivation to the sessions and especially to those young people who engage in the activities.

All sessions listed below are based on a 2hr session (unless stated otherwise)

- **One off session rate** which includes all the activities from the Go-Extreme flyer attached (but excluding the pro demo riders and shows, there are additional costs for these) = £375 per 2-hour session
- **Full School Holiday programme** - Including Easter, May half term, summer holidays, oct half term (10 weeks) - 10 session = £3500

- **Spring to Autumn Programme** – Easter holidays to October half term 29 Sessions = £9918
- **Winter Only Programme** – November to March (excluding Christmas break) 19 sessions = £6654
- **All year round provision** - (combination of outdoor and indoor sessions) client must supply an indoor venue. 48 weeks is based on cancellations throughout the year due to inclement weather and Christmas period closed down - 48 sessions = £16416

Youth Warm Hub Provision for Parish Councils

A warm, safe and informal indoor youth offer designed around the interests, lifestyle and social culture of today's young people.

What is it?

Indoor Sessions provide young people in year 7 above with a warm, welcoming and supervised place to meet friends, socialise, take part in activities, enjoy music and spend time in a positive community environment during the autumn and winter months November to March.

Why commission it?

A practical and visible youth provision for parish councils looking to support young people locally, make positive use of community venues and provide a modern offer that young people choose to attend.

The atmosphere

Relaxed, informal and non-structured. The environment is similar to the social side of a pub or cafe for adults - but without the bar - giving young people their own safe and supervised social space.

Activities may include

Not all activities are delivered at every session. The offer is tailored to the venue, age group and interests of the young people attending. Activities are delivered to venue

- Darts, pool and table tennis
- Table football and board games
- Games consoles and music
- Indoor Laser Tag and Ezy Rollers
- Slacklining, balance challenges and interactive activities

Venue suitability

Extreme Wheels will assess venue suitability before delivery to ensure sessions can be set up, supervised and delivered safely.

- Type, size and layout of main room
- Safe entry and exit routes
- Toilet location and accessibility
- Vehicle access for equipment
- Safe loading and unloading arrangements

Optional Enhancement: Urban Street Arts

This widens the reach and appeal of the sessions by providing creative routes for young people to participate, express themselves and be inspired.
