

Wilson's Field.

- Public parking ; Accessible; Lighting ; Seating; Tables; Rubbish bins ; Fitness equipment
- We have fabulous green parks/spaces in Farnsfield. Wilson's field is a great play space, well maintained. We use it for dog walking. Maybe more opportunities here to extend wild areas around perimeter, especially during no mow May. Our Parish council do a really excellent job of maintaining this area. Thanks to them all.
- Lady Goodwins. Can part of it be used for additional parking- we don't have enough centrally. Not sure putting more equipment there is good value as it was replaced recently and it is often unused. Acres. Senior football pitch needs a proper surface -removing mole hills (danger to small feet) good drainage and facilities for female changing/showers. Reynolds. Entrance via hedges can be muddy. Why not have gravel? Parfitt. Junior soccer? Same issues as above (senior Pitch) where would goal posts be stored? Where would cars park? Millennium woods. Very well used BUT can be muddy (bark chippings?) and some trails get overgrown. Squirrel park again can part be used for car parking? Generally 1. Cycle parking/appropriate paths 2. Improved access via Cotton Mill Lane for the Acres needed. No tree removal.

Be great to keep open spaces available for all, e.g. taking guides/rangers out for a picnic/game of rounders etc. currently use Reynolds field. Don't know the availability/accessibility of Wilson's field. Any proposal to develop or change use of green spaces should be widely consulted on.
